I am very pleased to announce that the Environmental Team have earned two gold stars for the school's ClimateCam plaque. The plaque is displayed in the school's front office. Peter Jones from the Educational Wetlands Centre presented the stars during our school assembly this week.

The Environmental Team have been using their critical thinking skills to work out how to make our school community more environmentally sustainable.

Along with Ms Wong, the team developed the school's Environmental Management Plan. The plan helps guide what environmental projects they will participate in and reflect on once completed.

The Environmental Team decided to work on recycling; reducing the amount of waste the school produces and increase the school's recycling capacity. The students have conducted waste audits to see how much and what types of rubbish we make.
