A message from Maitland High School

Due to increasing numbers of primary students being in high school grounds this year and as:

1. the high school has no information on the emergency or medical requirements, or the parent/carer information of these young children;
2. the high school has no knowledge of where, who or how many children on site on any given day; and
3. the high school has no knowledge of who is allowed to pick up students from school, primary school students are strongly encouraged to catch buses or be picked up by parent/carers, directly from their primary schools.

Any primary student catching a bus from the high school is required to be under the close supervision of the high school teacher at the front of the gate and not to be inside the school so that the teacher on duty is able to see the student and best meet their assumed duty of care.

It is essential for children to have regular dental check-ups as tooth decay can be entirely preventable, educating good oral hygiene will eliminate pain and major problems in the future. Examination– A thorough soft tissue examination of your child's teeth and gums.

Scale, clean & polish– Dental cleaning involving plaque removal.

Fluoride– Fluoride is a mineral that helps strengthen teeth and help prevent tooth decay.

Fissure sealants– safe and painless way of protecting teeth from decay. It is a plastic coating which covers the chewing surface of the adult tooth.

WE are very lucky to be involved in this free dental program, permission notes are required for each child and are available at the school office.
