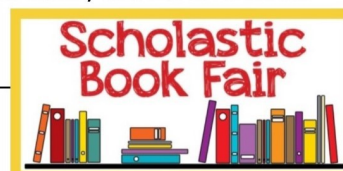

Library News

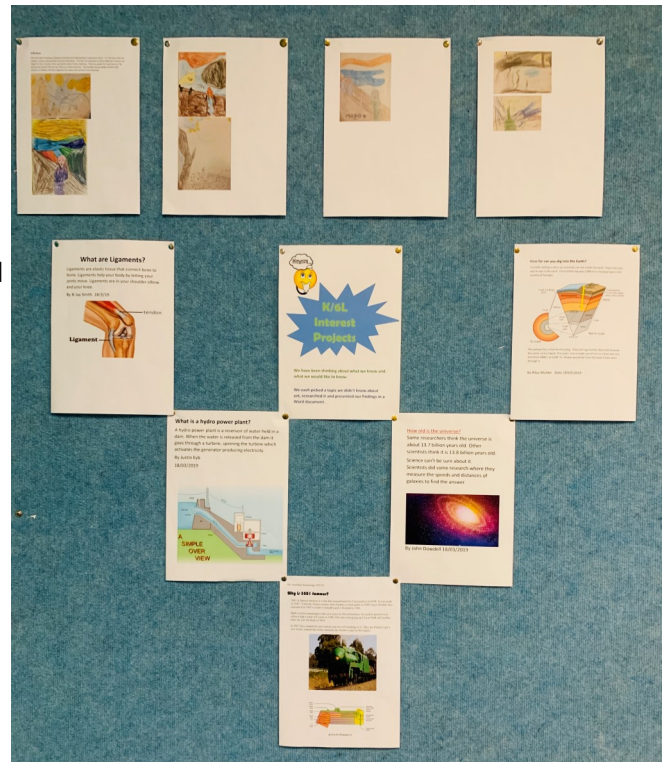
